**Lincoln Public Schools Rules**

The following conduct shall constitute grounds for suspension from practices, participation in interscholastic competition or other participation in co-curricular activities, when such conduct occurs on school grounds, or during an educational function or event off school grounds or off school grounds during the season of the particular activity.

KEEP THIS PORTION FOR YOUR RECORDS

1. Willfully disobeying any reasonable written or oral request of a school staff member or the voicing of disrespect to those in authority.
2. The use of violence, force, coercion, threat, intimidation or similar conduct in a manner that constitutes a substantial interference with school purposes.
3. Sexually assaulting or attempting to sexually assault any student or any school employee.
4. Willfully causing or attempting to cause substantial damage to private or school property, stealing or attempting to steal private or school property of substantial value or repeated damage or theft involving private or school property of small value.
5. Causing or attempting to cause physical injury to a school employee or to any student.
6. Threatening or intimidating any student for the purpose of, or with the intent of, obtaining money or anything of value from such student.
7. Knowingly possessing, handling or transmitting any object or material that is ordinarily or generally considered a weapon.
8. Engaging in the selling, using, possession or dispensing of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, narcotics, drugs (other than those prescribed by a physician), controlled substance, inhalant, or being under the influence of any of the above, or possession of drug paraphernalia.
9. Engaging in the selling, using, possessing or dispensing of material represented to be alcoholic beverages, narcotics, drugs, controlled substance or inhalants.
10. All activity participants are required to have on school records 20 hours of credit for the immediate preceding semester and must currently be taking 20 credit hours of instruction each week. Students enrolled in schools with modular scheduling are required to be enrolled in a minimum of 15 credit hours per quarter and must also pass a total of 20 credit hours the previous semester.
11. Failure to report for the activity at the beginning of each season; reporting for one activity may count as reporting on time if there is a change in activity within the season approved by the coach or supervisor.
12. Failure to participate in regularly scheduled classes on the day of an athletic/activity event.
13. Failure to attend all scheduled practices and meetings. If circumstances arise to prevent the participants' attendance, the validity of the reason will be determined by the coach. Every reasonable effort should be made to notify the coach or supervisor prior to all missed practices or meetings.
14. Truancy or failure to attend assigned classes or activities.
15. Tardiness to school, assigned classes or assigned activities.
16. The use of language which is profane or abusive to students or staff members.
17. Public indecency as defined in Nebraska statutes, except that this subdivision shall apply only to students at least 12 years of age.
18. Good sportsmanship shall be observed during practice sessions and contests.
19. Repeated violation of any of the rules adopted by the school district or the school.
20. Engaging in any other unlawful activity as determined by the United States or the State of Nebraska.
21. Dressing in a manner wherein such dress is dangerous to the student's health and safety or to the health and safety of others or is distractive or indecent to the extent that it interferes with the learning and teaching process.
22. Willfully violating the behavioral expectations for those students riding Lincoln Public Schools buses.
23. All other reasonable rules or regulations adopted by the coach or supervisor of a co-curricular activity shall be followed provided that participants shall be notified by the coach or supervisor of such rules and regulations by written handouts or posting on bulletin boards prior to the beginning of the season.
24. Failure to comply with any rule established by the Nebraska School Activities Association, including but not limited to, rules related to eligibility.
25. Students participating in interscholastic athletics are required to have a physical examination once each year, completed after May 1 of the current school year, which certifies the athlete is physically able to participate in interscholastic athletics. In accordance with LPS Form 526009 (Physical Examination Requirements) Lincoln Public Schools does not accept a physical examination completed by a chiropractor.

These rules are supplemental to Lincoln Public Schools policies 5480, 6721 and 6720 and any action taken hereunder may be in addition to any action taken under these policies.

**Due Process for Co-curricular Activities**

Students may be suspended by the principal or his/her designee from practices or participation in interscholastic competition or participation in co-curricular activities for violation of rules and standards of behavior adopted by the Lincoln Board of Education or the administrative staff of the school.

If a participant, the student's parents or guardian are not satisfied with the determination by the activity sponsor or coach, a hearing may be requested. However, the student will remain suspended from the activity pending the outcome of the hearing.

Procedures which will be followed with regard to suspension are contained in Lincoln Public Schools Policy and Regulation manual; Regulation 6740.1. A copy of this regulation may be obtained by contacting the Lincoln Public Schools activity office.

Additional procedures for due process for long-term suspension, expulsion or mandatory reassignment are found in Lincoln Public Schools Policy and Regulation manual; Regulation 5481.
