

Gifted Services at LSW

All Students: Access to advanced classes via self-selection
Information about special programs and resources
Access to counselors for support and course planning

Gifted Students: All of the above

Invitations to all meetings for gifted students and parents; 9th Grade meeting Sept. 10, 11th Grade meeting September 17, Future Hawk Night (incoming 8th Graders) January 16.

Hearing before the Program Design Team to recommend special services within the building if student's needs are not being met through school curriculum.

Appeal Process: Data Gathering Team and the LPS Steering Committee for Highly Gifted (HG) services based on alternate criteria. If the student needs additional services not provided at LSW, the Gifted Facilitator will request a meeting with the Gifted Steering Committee at LPS.

Personal Learning Plan (PLP) when appropriate for Gifted students.

Highly Gifted Students:

All of the above

Personal Learning Plan (PLP) when appropriate. The Personal Learning Plan for Highly Gifted students is a written document stating the goals of the mentorship and how they will be achieved; the respective department chair of the class being mentored approves it. The student, mentor, gifted facilitator and the parents/guardians of the student then sign the plan. The Gifted Facilitator will keep a copy of the PLP, turn in a copy to the district, and give a copy to the mentor and student. PLP conferences will be organized by the Facilitator on an "as needed" basis.

Option of mentorship paid by the district with a plan developed by the Data Gathering Team.

Option of UNL course with tuition and materials paid for by the district.
